

ECKLES TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES
July 10, 2018

Vice Chairman, Cory Wilson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Request by Supervisor Milender to pull the bills to address the way the beaver invoices were presented to the clerk.

Motion by Supervisor Milender, seconded by Supervisor Dougherty to accept the Consent Agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Supervisor Dougherty, seconded by Supervisor Milender to accept the Regular Agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

VISITORS:

Shaun Williams was representing Keith Hegg, who was unable to make the meeting to find out if the township could lower the speed limit on Balsam Road due to the dust. Chairman Hazeman had indicated to Keith he thought the township could. However; Supervisor Milender disagrees with the clarification of the law. Supervisor Milender will check with the MAT attorney next week while at MAT office.

Dennis Berglund approached the board regarding the flowage on his property and who was going to clean out his ditch.

After some discussion there was a consensus to put a clause in the Contract stating the Contractor needs to control the dust with water.

ROAD REPORT:

John Schocker has been placing chloride on the roads. Supervisor Dougherty indicated by putting less chloride on Wild Rose it has made it a good road. Residents are very pleased.

Century Link mailed a permit and maps requesting we sign and approve them to place fiber optic lines in Eckles Township. Supervisor Dougherty wants to modify some of the wording in their permit and will take responsibility for getting it signed.

The seeding and spraying has been completed in Deerfield Estates. There was a small hole made by the contractor that needs to be repaired. John Schocker indicated he could do it for \$50.00. The clerk will send an invoice to the Contractor and he will pay the township for the damages.

A discussion was held regarding the roads in Deerfield 1st Addition. They need to pull them in. All culverts will need aprons. That will be put in all new contracts.

Supervisor Wilson asked Supervisor Dougherty to meet him with Bob Michalicek to mark the limbs that need to be cut in the ROW.

Motion by Supervisor Dougherty, seconded by Supervisor Hendricks to accept the election judges for the Primary and General elections as named and on file in the Auditor-Treasurer Office.

Motion by Supervisor Dougherty, seconded by Supervisor Hendricks to adjourn.
