

**ECKLES TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES
November 9, 2022**

Present: Chairman, Donald Hazeman, Supervisors, Mel Milender, Cory Wilson; and Beth Hendricks; Treasurer, Debra Larson and Clerk Mary Lou Milender. Absent was Supervisor Bumgardner.

Public Attendees: Chris Gilbertson, Dale Wilson, Cheryl & Paul Cronemiller and Gary Coan.

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman, Don Hazeman. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Approval of Consent Agenda: Motion by Supervisor Wilson to approve the Consent Agenda. Second by Supervisor Milender Motion passed unanimously 4-0.

Approval of Agenda: Supervisor Hendricks made a motion to approve the November 9, 2022 Agenda. Second by Supervisor Wilson. Motion carried unanimously 4-0.

VISITORS:

Paul Cronemiller asked questions regarding the approaches and speed limits if the road is reconstructed once Cartway residents approve the easements. Supervisor Wilson informed him to mark where he wants any approaches. Standard approach is 30' ft. culvert and 20' approach. The Speed limit will be 35 mph.

ROAD REPORT:

Dale Wilson approached the board regarding his purchase of approximately 110 tons of shoulder material. Now he is not able to use it until the project is completed in the Spring. He wants to know if the board will advance some of the money he spent on the material. The board may consider it if he can provide a surety bond.

Supervisor Wilson informed the board about a beaver dam on Grant Creek Road. The beavers are backing up water by the Railroad grade. We may have to get an okay from pipeline to destroy the dam.

Discussion on Multi Unit-Housing. The board discussed a Moratorium as a way to slow down multi-family housing unit because they are being built without adequate road access that may adversely affect the Township in the future. Motion by Supervisor Wilson, seconded by Supervisor Hendricks to place a moratorium on additional multi-family housing units for a year or until the township has a chance to see what the township's options are. Motion carried unanimously. 4-0.

SHOOTING SPORTS:

In January, Mary Forseth will no longer be on the HSF Board. Phil Hodoff will be on the board.

Motion to adjourn by Supervisor Milender, seconded by Supervisor Hendricks. Motion carried unanimously. 4-0. Meeting adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
